I. ADMINISTRATIVE

Approval of Renaissance Charter Schools, Inc. Minutes from January 27, 2016

MOTION: Motion was made by Dennis Clark and seconded by John O'Brien to approve the minutes of the January 27, 2016 Renaissance Charter Schools, Inc. board meeting. Motion was approved (5-0)(2 absent).

II. SCHOOL REPORTS

School Reports

Renaissance Charter at Chickasaw Trail

- Principal Cindy Townsend presented the school report to the board to include enrollment at 1035 students with a budgeted amount of 1070
- Principal Townsend reported on the big push for enrollment and that there has been weekly simulated writing practice with the students. Teachers are giving feedback to the students on the stimulated writing practice within 48 hours.

Renaissance Charter at Hunters Creek

- Principal Nate Mariano presented the school report to the board to include enrollment at 847 students with a budgeted amount of 977 students. Recommitment is at 97%
- PTC events highlights include multicultural event and parent workshops. Tutorials are ongoing
 on Saturday for lower performing students as well as enrichment for the higher level students.

Renaissance Charter School at Hunters Creek

- Principal Vanessa Suarez Enrollment reported at 1053 students with a budgeted amount of 1070 students
- PTC events and highlights include: Recent SAC meeting, Science camp will be starting on 2/13/16 for 5th graders. There are 3 more enrollment sessions scheduled.

Renaissance Charter School at Poinciana

 Principal Angela Feliciano presented the school report to the board to include enrollment currently at 1093 for budget of 1095 budget

- PTC events and provided highlights to include: Saturday camp has over 105 students attending 3rd-8th grade. Daily tutoring for lowest 25% of students.
- Excellent partnership with Osceola School District with a mobile lab that recently came to the school and promotes collaboration between POIN students and students from other districts schools.

Renaissance Charter School at Tapestry

- Principal Jodi Evans presented the school report to the board to include enrollment reported at 872 students with a budgeted amount of 862 students.
- PTC events and highlights include FSA night with Olive Garden donating a spaghetti dinner. Over 200 parents attended.
- Saturday Camp has 20-25 teachers participating and as such, they have been able to open it up to the advanced gifted students as well as the lower performing students.

Four Corners Upper School

- Principal Denise Thompson presented the school report to the board to include enrollment reported at 705 students with a budgeted amount of 750 students.
- PTC activities and school highlights to include: There is an Open House Night is scheduled for 2/11/16 and a PTC SAC meeting scheduled on 2/25 that will also be their Multicultural Night.
- HS internship that will allow students to have technology certification.
- Recommitment in the middle school is 572 and for the high school is 126.
