Approval of the January 10, 2018 Board Meeting Minutes

MOTION: A motion was made by Dennis Clark and seconded by John O'Brien to approve the January 10, 2018 Board Meeting Minutes for Renaissance Charter School, Inc. Motion passed unanimously. (4-0, 2 absent)

#### II. CSUSA REPORTS

#### ASAP School Update

- Rita Weaver introduced the ASAP Academic Schools as well as the ASAP Enrollment schools and the overview and goals for the ASAP teams
- Vanessa Suarez introduced herself as the Principal assisting at Chickasaw while Ms.
  Townsend was on leave and updated the board on the school's progress, highlights to
  include: new technology introduced at the school, update on the tutoring program and
  the continued focus on RTI and a review of the flash report, including a discussion with
  the board on the flash survey results and key indicators coming from the winter NWEA
  initial results.
- Mr. Rodney Hull, Principal at Keys Gate Charter High School updated the board on the school's progress towards meeting its goals, highlights include continued focus on data chats with the teachers and monitoring the students' progress, an update on the tutoring program, which includes a focus on Algebra I. Mr. Hull also reviewed the flash report for the school.
- Mr. Sheriffee Humphrey, Principal at Renaissance Charter School Plantation updated the board on his preliminary NWEA winter results as well as an overview of UNISIG Grant: approval of special intervention kits for the RTI program, addition technology to support increased software usage, and the monitoring of the digital curriculum programs and assessments.
- Mr. James Simpson, Principal at Governors Charter Academy updated the board on his academic focus at the school, highlights which include expanding the tutoring program to include and target the lowest 30 percent of students, focus on increasing the usage of instructional software programs, which are looking at implementing incentives to teachers and students and conducting additional professional development for the staff on NWEA results and how to best monitor and implement instruction based on the results. Mr. Simpson also update the board on his participation on being a part of the ASAP Enrollment team and his participation at the enrollment summit on 1/22/18. Board Chair Mr. Haiko and Board Member Mr. O'Brien attended the enrollment summit as well as updated the board on the various initiatives and approaches that the schools

and CSUSA are implementing to increase the enrollment for the 2018-19 school year. Mr. Simpson also reviewed the flash report and answered questions from the board.

#### **ASAP Grade Monitoring**

 Rita Weaver presented preliminary projections based on the NWEA winter results and other various data points for the asap schools. Each Principal also discussed the projections and the opportunities for improvement to impact the testing scores. All questions were answered by the Principals and Mrs. Weaver.
