#### **CALL TO ORDER**

Pursuant to public notice, the meeting commenced at 10:34am with a Call to Order by Chairman Ken Haiko. Roll call was taken, and quorum established.

### I. ADMINISTRATIVE

### II. CSUSA REPORTS

#### **NWEA Winter Results**

- Dr. Eddie Ruiz, Florida State Director, presented to the board the NWEA Winter Results
  as well as the schools FSA projections. Dr. Ruiz reviewed the Schools' 2017/18 School
  Grades and the projections made during the NWEA Winter data in order to show the
  accuracy of the projections, as well as the individual school dash boards the State
  Executive Team and the CSUSA Executive team has been using to monitor the data
  across the network and the Board's portfolio of schools.
- Dr. Tony Stewart, Principal, reviewed the dashboard for Renaissance Charter School at Cypress and the projections as well as several initiatives already implemented in order to exceed the school grade projections.
- Rachel Windler-Freitag reviewed the NWEA Winter Results by area and all questions were answered by Mrs. Windler-Freitag, Dr. Ruiz, and Dr. Stewart.
