#### I. ADMINISTRATIVE

Approval of the July 14, 2021 Renaissance Charter School, Inc. Board Meeting Minutes

• The board reviewed the meeting minutes.

MOTION: Motion was made by Dennis Clark and seconded by Billie Miller to approve the Meeting Minutes from the July 14, 2021 Renaissance Charter School, Inc. Board meeting, as presented. Motion was approved unanimously. (7-0)

#### II. CSUSA REPORTS

#### State Director Report

• Dr. Ruiz advised the board that summer bridge programs wrapped up in July and that the schools have had successful IMPACT events with positive feedback from teachers.Dr. Ruiz also reported out to the Board that the first day of school at most of the schools were this week. Dr. Ruiz was visiting multiple schools and enrollment is looking good at those schools he visited.

#### School Accountability Data - Opt In

- Rita Weaver reviewed the FDOE Order No. 2021-EO-02, issued on April 9, 2021, and the FDOE Memorandum dated July 29 20221 and State Board of Education Rule 6A-1.09981, Florida Administrative Code issued that outlines the process for opting into grades. The DOE will not be issuing grades, and CSUSA reviewed the data released and after an analysis of the datat which included a decision tree, has recommended the following schools opt into receiving a grade:
  - o Renaissance Charter School at Boggy Creek
  - o Renaissance Charter School at St. Lucie.
- Billie Miller and the board asked that the messaging be consistent and is important regarding the opting in of school grades.

MOTION: Motion was made by Billie Miller and seconded by Pat Smith to approve opting into school grades as per Florida Administrative Code Rule 6A-1.0998 for Renaissance Charter School at Boggy Creek and Renaissance Charter School at St. Lucie, as presented. Motion was approved unanimously. (7-0)

• Rita Weaver updated the board on the charter renewal for Renaissance Charter School at University which included the application due dates and timelines.

#### FY22 Charter Renewals

- The board discussed the charters up for renewal and would request 5-year renewals for the following schools:
  - o Governors Charter Academy
  - o Renaissance Charter School at Boggy Creek
  - o Renaissance Charter School at Crown Point
  - o Renaissance Charter School at Tapestry
- The Board discussed high performing status of Duval Charter School at Coastal and requesting a 15 renewal.

MOTION: A motion was made by Tom Wheeler and seconded by Dennis Clark to approve the request for renewals for 5-years for the following schools: Governors Charter Academy, Renaissance Charter School at Boggy Creek, Renaissance Charter School at Crown Point, Renaissance Charter School at Tapestry, and a 15-year renewal request for Duval Charter School at Coastal, as presented. Motion was approved unanimously. (7-0)

#### Doral Expansion Update

- Rita Weaver updated the board on the Renaissance Middle Charter School expansion, now known as Renaissance Upper Charter School, and the location of the new campus.
- The Board reviewed the sub lease with RECS and Red Apple Development, Inc. Board Attorney Levi Williams has reviewed the lease for legal form and sufficiency.

#### MOTION: A motion was made by Pat Smith and seconded by John O'Brien to approve the lease between Renaissance Charter School, Inc. and Red Apple Development Inc., as presented. Motion was approved unanimously. (7-0)

#### Broward Calendar

• The board reviewed the edits to the Broward calendar and noted no impact to instructional hours.

MOTION: A motion was made by Tom Wheeler and seconded by Billie Miller to approve the Broward County Calendar for the Renaissance Charter School, Inc. Broward portfolio, as presented. Motion was approved unanimously. (7-0)

#### Teacher Certification

• The board reviewed the teacher certification expiration extensions provided in the packet.

#### Parent/Student Handbook Addendum

- The board reviewed the parent/student handbook welcome back addendum and discussed COVID protocols, as well as the guidance given in the Florida DOE memo regarding masks. The board also discussed the staff mask mandate.
- Billie Miller was conflicted regarding rising COVID cases, but does not support a mask mandate and asks that language is "strongly recommend the wearing of masks for students".

MOTION: A motion was made by Billie Miller and seconded by Tom Wheeler to approve the FY22 Parent/Student Handbook Addendum, with the requested edits, as presented. Motion was approved unanimously. (7-0)

MOTION: A motion was made by Pat Smith and seconded by Tom Wheeler to approve the CSUSA Student Progression Plan for the Renaissance Charter School, Inc. portfolio of schools in the following counties: Palm Beach, St. Lucie, and Duval, as presented. Motion was approved unanimously. (7-0)

#### Duval 3rd Grade COVID Exemption

• Dr. Eddie Ruiz discussed with the board that Duval county had a 3<sup>rd</sup> grade COVID exemption in the student progression plan and that CSUSA did not. The board discussed.

#### CSUSA Compensation Performance Plan

- The board discussed the CSUSA Compensation Performance Plan. Several board members expressed their dissatisfaction with the amounts for the average salary and adders for graduate degrees. The board discussed the consequences of not approving the plan which included the schools being out of compliance on this benchmark for the districts. Rachel Windler-Freitag outlined the statutory requirements met within the plan.
- The board requested that CSUSA use creativity to increase teacher compensation as a way to recruit and retain teachers.

MOTION: A motion was made by Pat Smith and seconded by Paul Sallarulo to approve the CSUSA Compensation Performance Plan, as presented. Motion was approved. (4 yay-Haiko, Smith, Sallarulo, Clark to 3 nay-Miller, Wheeler, O'Brien)
