CALL TO ORDER

Pursuant to public notice, the meeting commenced at 10:32 a.m. with a Call to Order by Chairman Ken Haiko. Roll call was taken, and quorum established.

I. PUBLIC COMMENTS

Board Chair Ken Haiko called for public comments.

Speaker Kamalla Livres informed the board that she read the updated covid policies and has a concern about the freedom of choice for vaccine, testing options, and facial covering. As a parent and staff of the school, she is concerned since she is pregnant and is not given a choice, instead the choice is made by someone else and it affects her body and health and breathing. The second policy stating the 5 days of PTO for COVID positive employess are only for vaccinated individuals vs. unvaccinated ones again is very discriminatory for people that are making choices about thier bodies. Some people choose not to get vaccinated or wear a mask and that should be their right, therefore, can the policy be revisited.

II. ADMINISTRATIVE

<u>Approval of the December 15, 2021 Renaissance Charter School, Inc. Board Meeting Minutes</u> The board reviewed the meeting minutes.

MOTION: Motion was made by Billie Miller and seconded by Paul Sallarulo to approve the meeting minutes from the December 15, 2021 Renaissance Charter School, Inc. board meeting, as presented. Motion was approved unanimously. (4-0, 2 absent)

III. CSUSA REPORTS

State Director Report

- State Director Dr. Eddie Ruiz updated the board on the surge in COVID cases due to the new variant and returning from winter break and that the CSUSA policy on mandating masks for all adults in the building and strongly recommended masks for students is still in place, as are the COVID protocols implemented at the beginning of the school year.
- The board discussed the winter assessment testing and the tiering of the schools. Dr. Ruiz advised that the State Directors and Deputies will be meeting in February to review the status of the Tier 3 schools and the iniatives in place to improve student outcomes. The Board will review this data at the March meeting.
- The Board also discussed the implementation of the Teacher Compensation Plan ("TCP")
 and that it would begin to be paid out in January. Human Resources is currently
 conducting a compensation analysis on non-instructional positions and leadership and
 that will be brought to the Board in the coming months.

Mrs. Rachel Windler Freitag, Area 1 Deputy director reviewed iPass which is the process that the leadership team provides support to the Tier 3 schools

V. OLD BUSINESS

Charter Renewals Update

 Billie Miller discussed attending the renewal visit at Renaissance Charter School at Crown Point ("RCCP") and commended Principal Taylor and his staff for all of the creativity and positive culture they have. The children were excited and involved as was the staff.

- The Drama students performed a skit from the movie Shrek and Music teacher, Mr.
 Mason introduced the percussion group for a performance for the Governing Board. The Governing Board thanked the students for their enthusiasm and performance.
- Principal Taylor also reviewed with the board the Aquaponics Farm that the school has as
 a highlight and outlined that as there currently is no "Aquaponics Curriculum", the
 instructional staff at RCCP incorporate a variety of Standards in their instruction utilizing
 the farm. RCCP will be selling the produce to parents.
- Board Member Billie Miller requested that the Board incorporate a school presentation similar to the RCCP presentation at every board meeting.

The Board discussed the Renaissance Middle Charter School expansion. The item was pulled from the Miami Dade School board January Board meeting as the contract needs to be amended removing the location as the location proposed is no longer an option. The grade expansion will continue the 5-8 and then move to a 6-12 for FY23.

MOTION: Motion was made by Billie Miller and seconded by Dennis Clark to approve the revision of the Renaissance Middle Charter School Expansion Contract, as presented. Motion was approved unanimously.

 The Board discussed the board meeting scheduled for February 9, 2022 and discussed changing it to February 2, 2022. The Board discussed moving the March meeting from March 9th to March 11, 2022. The board scheduled the June board meeting on June 28, 2022.
