CALL TO ORDER

Pursuant to public notice, the meeting commenced at 12:35pm with a Call to Order by Chairman Ken Haiko. Roll
call was taken, and quorum established.

I. PUBLIC COMMENTS

Board Chair Ken Haiko called for public comments. There were no public comments.

II. ADMINISTRATIVE

Approval of February 14, 2023, Renaissance Charter School, Inc. Board Meeting Minutes

• The board reviewed the February 14, 2023, Renaissance Charter School, Inc. Board Meeting minutes. Paul Sallarullo was present, not absent as the draft indicated. The minutes will be edited accordingly.

MOTION: Motion was made by Tom Wheeler and seconded by Pat Smit to approve the February 14, 2023, Renaissance Charter School, Inc. Board Meeting Minutes, as edited. The motion was approved unanimously. (5-0, 1 absent)

III. CSUSA REPORTS

The board asked Dr. Eddie Ruiz to attend meetings in person whenever possible.

State Director Update

- Dr. Eddie Ruiz updated the board on recent activities which included second QUEST visits at the Tier 3 schools and preparing for PM3 testing.
- The board visited Duval Charter School at Scholars ("DCSA") and thanked Deputy Hamlin and the
 Principal for walking them through the school and the plan to improve student outcomes. The
 Board requested that the state team push in to support DCSA with administration, enrollment,
 and all operations etc. so that the leadership staff at the school can focus on instructional efforts.

Duval Food RFP Update

• The board reviewed that the Duval schools have been renewed 4 times and National School Lunch Program requirements state that the food service must go out with a mandatory RFP.

The board reviewed its February FTE survey count for its portfolio of schools.

MOTION: Motion was made by Paul Sallarulo and seconded by Billie Miller to accept the CSUSA State Director's Report, as presented. The motion was approved unanimously.

IV. FINANCIALS

Q2 FY23 Unaudited Financial Review

 The board reviewed the Q2 FY23 Unaudited Financial Results for the portfolio of Renaissance Charter School, Inc. schools and all questions were answered by Ms. Lisanne Morton.

MOTION: Motion was made by Billie Miller and seconded by Tom Wheeler to approve Q2 FY23 Unaudited Financial Results for the Renaissance Charter School, Inc. portfolio of schools, as presented. The motion was approved unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS

Business Development

 Renaissance Charter School at Boggy Creek has officially been renamed as Renaissance Academy of Arts and Sciences and the grade configuration will now be k-12. The board discussed the maximum enrollment of 1,750 and the School District of Osceola County ("SDOC") request for an amendment to the charter to include that maximum number of students.

MOTION: Motion was made by Pat Smith and seconded by Paul Sallarulo to approve the submission of an amendment to the Renaissance Academy of Arts and Sciences charter contract including a maximum enrollment of 1,750 for grades K-12. Motion was approved unanimously.

The board discussed Osceola 1 and Osceola 2 charters on the shelf and the expiration of the planning time.
 Dr. Eddie Ruiz has discussed with the SDOC, the request to expand the charter term and planning time through Fall of 2026 for both charters.

MOTION: Motion was made by Billie Miller and seconded by Pat Smith for the submission of an amendment to both Osceola 1 and Osceola 2 charters on the shelf extending the term an additional 5 years to 2032 with an additional 2 years of planning for an opening of Fall of 2026. Motion was approved unanimously.

• The board reviewed the replication letter of intent to St. Johns County replicating Duval Charter School at Coastal, an FDOE designated high-performing school.

MOTION: Motion was made by Tom Wheeler and seconded by Paul Sallarulo to approve the submission of the Letter of Intent to replicate Duval Charter School at Coastal to St. Johns County School Board, as presented. The motion was approved unanimously.

• The board reviewed the letter for a teacher certificate extension from Renaissance Charter School at St. Lucie.

MOTION: Motion was made by Pat Smith and seconded by Paul Sallarulo to approve the teacher certificate extension request, as presented. The motion was approved unanimously.

V. NEW BUSINESS

FY24 School Calendars

The board tabled this agenda item.

Out of Field Waivers

• The board reviewed the out of field waivers presented.

Renaissance Charter School at St. Lucie Florida High School Athletic Association Membership

• The board reviewed the requirements for membership in the Florida High School Athletic Association Membership and discussed the districts requirement of the K-8 becoming a member in order to have referees at their school sporting events.

MOTION: Motion was made by Tom Wheeler and seconded by Billie Miller to approve the Renaissance Charter School at St. Lucie application for membership in the Florida High School Athletic Association, as presented. The motion was approved unanimously.

Articulation Agreement with Downtown Miami Charter School, Inc.

• The board discussed partnering with CSUSA managed sister-school and governing board in assisting with middle school programmatic placement. Downtown Miami Charter School is moving to a K-5 and the population at that school is not centered in downtown Miami and the partnership could help the RECS middle schools in the South Florida area. The RECS board has two similar articulation agreements with other governing boards in the state. MOTION: Motion was made by Paul Sallarulo and seconded by Billie Miller to approve articulation agreement with Downtown Miami Charter School, Inc. and authorize Chair to execute, as presented. The motion was approved unanimously.

VI. ADJOURNMENT
