CALL TO ORDER

Pursuant to public notice, the meeting commenced at 9:31am with a Call to Order by Chairman Ken Haiko. Roll call was taken, and quorum established.

I. PUBLIC COMMENTS

Board Chair Ken Haiko called for public comments. There were no public comments.

V. Old Business - Referendum Litigation Update

- Ed Pozzuoli discussed with the board the Referendum Audit Request for Broward County.
- Ed Pozzuoli provided the board information regarding the Referendum Allocation and Disbursement Miami-Dade County School. He asked the board to file action against Miami-Dade County to obtain the funds owed to the Renaissance Charter Schools, Inc. located within Miami-Dade County.
- Mr. Pozzuoli provided the board with a referendum litigation update. He stated that mediation in this case is set for December, and he will provide the board an update as the case progresses.
- Mr. Pozzuoli thanked Board Attorney, Levi Williams and the Board Members for their assistance with the funding issues and asked for the approval of filing of litigation.

MOTION: Motion was made by Paul Sallarulo and seconded by Billie Miller to approve the filing of the action of breach of contract and damages presented for Renaissance Charter School, Inc. in Miami Dade County. The motion was approved unanimously. (5-1, 1 absent)

III. CSUSA REPORTS

State Superintendent Update

- Dr. Ruiz updated the board on the accountability retreat that was held in October. The focus
 centered around marketing and enrollment and how to improve enrollment at the under enrolled
 schools.
- Dr. Ruiz stated that Keys Gate High School is working with Marketing and Enrollment to increase enrolment and considering other ways to improve the school.
- Dr. Ruiz provided an update on Warrington Preparatory Academy. He provided the FDOE an update
 on Warrington at the State Board Meeting in October. Warrington was awarded a seven million
 dollar grant from the Triumph Gulf Coast Board, which will be presented to the board in a future
 meeting.
- Dr. Ruiz provided a teacher staffing update and presented the school goals for Renaissance Charter Schools portfolio of schools.
- Mr. Wheeler asked if Dr. Ruiz thought there is a correlation between low enrollment, teacher turn over, and school grade.

- Billie Miller said the same schools have the same issues and what are we doing to improve it? She also stated that salary is not the only reason school's struggle. Dr. Ruiz responded stating that coaching for leaders at every level is being provided to improve school culture.
- Billie Miller state that when the board agreed to take on Warrington, she was concerned that CSUSA did not have the infrastructure in place to support this school. Dr. Ruiz stated that interviews are being held to find additional staffing for the school. However, we will not settle for any candidate according to Dr. Ruiz. CSUSA will continue to rotate staff in to support Warrington until the school is fully staffed with the right people.
